Job profile – Statistician

The candidate shall report directly to the Programme Coordinator at iCALL, and shall assist with the following:

- Checking, cleaning and coding existing call and email related data
- Applying advanced statistical analyses and working with large datasets
- Using statistical softwares for assessing results and analyzing data trends
- Presenting complex statistical information effectively in a variety of formats to different stakeholders iCALL works with (such as mental health professionals, social workers, government and non-governmental organizations, the corporate sector)
- Acting in a consultancy capacity for various ongoing research projects at iCALL and implementing data gathering/management models.



Desirous candidates should:

- Possess a full-time Master's Degree in Psychology / Human Development / Social Work (with a Mental Health specialization) from a recognized and reputed University.
- Have at least 1 year of prior experience of working with social sciences / mental health / psychological data.
- Should have sound understanding of a wide variety of statistical methods and data analyses
- Should know to apply their deep knowledge of statistics in diverse contexts
- Speak English and Hindi and at preferably one regional Indian language fluently
- Possess excellent mathematical and analytical skills
- Be skilled in the use of computers and statistical softwares for the purpose of documentation, data analysis (quantitative & qualitative)
- Possess excellent verbal and written communication skills to effectively communicate findings of the statistical analyses

Preference shall be given to candidates based in Mumbai and with a background in mental health. Candidates not having an academic background in Psychology / Mental Health need not apply. The position is for a period of four months.

Please note that this is a full-time position. Salary shall be INR 25,000 per month.
